PLATONIC LOVE LEONARDO PIVI

Piazza XXV Aprile, Milan Monday 22nd September–Friday 24th October

From Monday, September 22, the exhibition 'Platonic Love' by the artist Leonardo Pivi will continue, moving from the gallery spaces of Gluck50 to the public soil of Piazza XXV Aprile in Milan, where a large-size imposing sculpture specially designed for one of the most suggestive architectural and urban sites in the city on the will be on display.

Consisting of a three meters majestic young beardless colossus holding a doll, the sculpture is hermetically closed in a synthetic shell that creates a surreal, aseptic and disquieting atmosphere, deliberately conceived to create a barrier aimed at overshadowing any interpretation.

The event takes place at the end of a project Pivi started during the month of May in the prestigious residency for artists Gluck50.

'Platonic Love' is the most emblematic expression of Pivi's new sculptural figurative cycle, where ancient stylistic elements blend with a contemporary and personal feel of a conceptual nature.

The artwork will be exhibited till Friday 24th October.
